2016 results

2016 RESULTS

We applaud and celebrate the achievements of every young woman at MLC School, especially those of the 2016 Year 12 cohort. Using the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)* as a measure, we can combine the results of the HSC and the IB to summarise the cohort's performance in 2016.

- 50% of the 2016 cohort achieved a combined ATAR over 90 in the HSC and IB while 35% achieved an ATAR over 95.
- Six of our IB students achieved a perfect score of 45 (equating to an ATAR of 99.95) and five achieved a score of 44 (equating to an ATAR of 99.85).

HSC HIGHLIGHTS

- There were 95 instances of students being awarded Band 6 or E4 (the highest bands possible).
- 42 students were placed on the HSC Distinguished Achievers list for those who achieved a result in the highest possible Band for one or more courses.
- 53% of the cohort achieved a Band 6 in at least one subject.
- In 22 of the 25 subjects sat by our students the results in Bands 5 and 6 exceeded the state average.
- 100% of Music 2 and French Extension students achieved a Band 6.
- 100% of Music 1 students achieved Bands 5 and 6.
- 100% of English Extension 1 students achieved Bands 5 and 6.
- 100% of History Extension students achieved Bands 5 and 6.
- 100% of Textiles and Design students achieved Bands 5 and 6.
- Three students will be exhibited as part of ArtExpress, one student was selected for presentation at OnSTAGE and one student was selected for the Texstyle showcase.

IB HIGHLIGHTS

- Six student achieved a perfect score of 45 (99.95 ATAR) and five students achieved 44, the highest number of perfect scores in Australia.
- 31% of our IB students achieved an ATAR of 99 or over.
- The worldwide average score among IB students was 29.21 – at MLC School it was 38.5.
- Of the 30 perfect scores in Australia, 20% came from MLC School.

*The Australian Tertiary Admission Rank, or ATAR, is a percentile awarded to students for application into undergraduate university programs upon completion of Year 12 in all Australian States except Queensland. The maximum rank attainable is 99.95.
