PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Fee statements are sent out at the start of each term and are payable within **14** days. We seek your support in ensuring these payment terms are met.
- There is an early payment discount applicable when fees are paid by the due date, but a late payment fee of \$75 will apply if fees are not paid by the due date each term.
- Sibling Discount is 10% for the second child, 12.5% for the third and subsequent children.
- A student cannot commence a new term whilst the previous term's fees remain unpaid.**
- Our preferred payment option is BPay.
- Year 12 families are billed at the beginning of Term 1, Term 2 and Term 3.
- A term's notice in writing to the Principal is required for student withdrawal, otherwise a term's fee will be payable.**

2019 RESULTS

Congratulations to our Year 12 girls for their effort, commitment and diligence during 2019. Completing Year 12 is no easy feat. Our girls showed great character and resilience; and were always willing to support one another throughout the roller coaster ride that is Year 12. These girls immersed themselves in a full range of co-curricular activities, served the wider community, demonstrated great leadership and dedicated themselves to their academic studies.

HSC HIGHLIGHTS

- 4 girls achieved State rankings in their subjects – 2nd in Indonesian, 5th in Japanese Beginners, 6th in Industrial Technology and 9th in Textiles and Design
- 64% of the 2019 HSC cohort achieved a Band 6 in at least one subject.
- There were 96 instances of students awarded a Band 6 or E4.
- 49 girls were placed on the HSC Distinguished Achievers list for those who achieved a result in the highest possible Band for one or more courses.
- 100% of students achieved a Band 5 or Band 6 in the following subjects: Drama, Entertainment Industry Examination, Geography, Indonesian Continuers, Japanese Beginners, Music 1, Music 2, Textiles and Design and Visual Arts
- 100% of students achieved an E4 in the following subjects: English Extension 2, History Extension, Indonesian Extension, Music Extension, Science Extension
- 95% of English Extension 1 students achieved an E4.

IB HIGHLIGHTS

- Four students achieved a perfect score of 45 (equating to an ATAR of 99.95)
- Four students achieved a score of 44 (equating to an ATAR of 99.85).
- Thirteen students achieved an ATAR of 99 and over.
- 64% of students achieved an ATAR equivalent of 95 or over.
- 76.5% of students achieved an ATAR equivalent of 90 or over.
- The average score among IB students at MLC School was 38 which represents an ATAR equivalent to 96.45

*The Australian Tertiary Admission Rank, or ATAR, is a percentile awarded to students for application into undergraduate university programs upon completion of Year 12 in all Australian States except Queensland. The maximum rank attainable is 99.95.
